

One-Step

Castle Walk

In this step, both man and woman walk stiff-legged, rising on the balls of the feet, man walking forward, woman backward, swaying shoulders slightly.

Each series in these photographs A to B, B to C, C to D, etc., represent the change in position of feet as couple performs this step.






Pony Step

This step is performed in the same manner as the Castle Walk, man going forward, woman backward, both man and woman making a slight hop on each step. Man goes forward on left foot, woman back with right, man hopping slightly on left foot, woman on right (Series A to B) then man forward with right foot, woman back with left, man hopping slightly with right foot, woman with left (B to C).

Otherseries Cto D, D to E, etc., represent each change of feet in performing this step.

Reverse Dip Step

In this step, the man holds the woman out at his right side, man facing forward, woman backward. Man walks forward beginning with left foot, woman with right, walking 1-2-3 (See series A to B) man throwing weight on right foot, starting back on left foot walks 1-2-3 (B to C) man dipping on right foot, woman on left (C to D) and repeat, man beginning with left foot, woman with right, walking 1-2-3 (D to E.)


Get-Over Step

Man's Part-

Starting with left foot, man walks 1-2 (See series A to B) crosses left foot over right (B to C) shifting weight from left to right. back to left, counting 1-2-3 (C to D) walking forward on right. kicking with left (keeping knee of left leg straight) (D to E) forward on left kicking with right (E to F) forward on right. weight on right foot. turning in and facing partner drawing left foot (F to G) then weight on left foot drawing right (G to H.)

Woman's Part-


Starting with right foot woman walks 1-2 (A to B) crosses right foot over left (B to C) shifting weight from right foot to left back to right counting 1-2-3 (C to D) then walking forward on left kicking with right (D to E) forward on right kicking with left (E to F) turning in and facing partner weight on left foot drawing right (F to G) weight on right drawingleft(GtoH.)





Man starts with left foot, woman with right walking forward 1-2-3 (A to B) both man and woman turning in on third step walking forward, man beginning with right, woman with left walking 1-2-3, both man and woman turning in on third count (B to C) walking forward, man with left woman with right 1-2-3 (C to D.)

Series D to E shows the beginning of another step.


Hesitation Waltz


Man's Part-

Man starts waltzing with right foot back, waltzing 1-2-3. hesitating on left foot 1-holding 2-3 See series (A to B) and repeat (B to C) repeating (C to D) repeating again (D to E) making quarter turns.

Woman's Part-

Woman starts waltzing left foot forward, waltzing 1-2-3. hesitating on right foot and holding 2-3 (See series A to B) repeating (B to C) repeating (C to D) repeating again (D to E) making quarter turns.






Side Hesitation

This step is danced by using the same step as the basic step in the hesitation, both man and woman waltzing 1-2-3, man hesitating on left foot, holding 2-3, woman hesitating on right foot, holding 2-3, both man and woman waltzing back and forward. When man goes forward. woman goes back (See series A to B) when mangoes back. woman goes forward (B to C.) The man is always on the inside; the woman on the outside.

Hesitation

Skating Dip Step

Thisis arunning step, both man and woman starting with inside foot, man with right, woman with left, running 1-2-3, dipping, man with left, woman withright 1—holding 2-3. (See series A to B) repeating (B to C) and repeating again (C to D.)


Hesitation Balance with Dip


Man's Part-

Man balances back on right foot (Series A to B) starting with left foot forward walking 1-2-3 (B to C) dipping on right (C to D) back on right 1-2-3 (D to E) dipping on right (E to F) and repeat.

Woman's Part-

Woman balances back on left foot (A to B) forward beginning with right foot 1-2-3 (B to C) dipping on left foot (C to D) back on left foot 1-2-3 (D to E) dipping on left (E to F) and repeat.





Hesitation Walking Dip and Reverse

Man's Part-

Man starting with left foot, walks 1-2-3-4 (See series A to B) making a full turn, turning in towards partner (B to C) dipping on left foot (C to D) starting with right foot, walking 1-2 (D to E) making a full turn (E to F) turning in towards partner, dipping on right foot (F to G) and repeat.

Woman's Part-

Starting with right foot woman walks 1-2-3-4 (See series A to B) making a full turn, turning in towards partner (B to C) dipping on right foot (C to D) starting with left foot, walking 1-2 (D to E) making full turn turning in towards partner (E to F) dipping on left foot (F to G.)

Tango


Cortez Step


Woman's Part-

Left foot forward counting 1— (A to B) right foot out to side shifting weight to right and back to left counting 2-3 (B to C) right foot forward counting four (C to D) holding fifth count.

Man's Part-

Right foot back counting 1— (A to B) left foot out to side shifting weight to left and back to right counting 2-3 (B to C) left foot back (C to D) counting four and holding for fifth count.





Man's Part-

Right foot back (A to B) left foot out to side shifting weight to left and back to right (B to C) holding right foot (C to D) and repeat (D to E.)

Woman's Part-

Left foot forward (AtoB) right foot out to side shifting weight to right and back to left (B to C) holding left foot (C to D) and repeat (D to E.)




Seven Step

Man's Part-

Man walks forward beginning with left foot, walking 1-2-3 (A to B) left foot in back of right swinging foot out to side putting weight on left foot (B to C) then shift weight to right and turn in facing partner (C to D) place left foot in front of right turning out (D to E.)

Woman's Part-

Beginning with right foot woman walks forward 1-2-3 (A to B) right foot in back of left putting weight on right foot (B to C) then weight on left foot turning in with right foot in front of left (C to D) turning out and repeat (D to E.)





Man's Part-

Manusamon

Man starts forward with right foot (A to B) left foot in front of right putting weight on it (B to C) weight back on right (C to D) left foot back of right putting weight on it (D to E) right foot back of left putting weight on it (E to F) shifting weight to (F) and repeat.

Woman's Part-

Woman starts forward with left foot (A to B) right foot in front of left putting weight on it (B to C) weight back on left (C to D) right foot back of left putting weight on it (D to E) left foot back of right putting weight on it (E to F) shifting weight foot (F to G) and repeat.

G to H show the couple beginning another step.

Mr. and Mrs. Vernon Castle's Suggestions

For Correct Dancing

Do not wriggle the shoulders.

Do not shake the hips.

Do not twist the body.

Do not flounce the elbows.

Do not pump the arms.


Do not hop—glide instead.

Avoid low, fantastic and acrobatic dips.

Stand far enough away from each other to allow free movement of the body in order to dance gracefully and comfortably.

The gentleman should rest his hand lightly against lady's back, touching her with the finger tips and wrist only, or, if preferred, with the inside of the wrist and back of the thumb.

The gentleman's left hand and forearm should be held up in the air parallel with his body, with the hand extended, holding the lady's hand lightly on his palm. The arm should never be straightened out.
